

VFX - Wheelchair Lunging Flo Puppet - How-To Guide

SETTING UP AND USING THE PUPPET

Unpack your puppet carefully. Put the puppet in the wheelchair (Not included) being careful to slide the foot peddle through the back of the chair.



Use the strap included to secure the base to the wheelchair seat.



Use the white arm restraints to secure Flo's arms to the wheelchair arms.



Run the cord from the sound system up to the wheelchair handle and attach with the included zip ties. Make sure to cover the button pad with the cover before attaching.



USE: Turn on the Puppet Master Sound System™ and test the buttons on the button pad to make sure it's working. Adjust the volume to the desired level. Now you can push Flo around and operate the sounds and use the foot peddle to lung the creature out to startle unsuspecting victims.

HOW TO CARE FOR YOUR ATTACK LINE PUPPET

PUPPETEER - The right person for the best results.

To keep your puppet in the best shape possible for years the **#1 tip is PUT IT IN THE RIGHT HANDS!** You need a responsible person to puppeteer and take care of your puppet. Use your best judgement here.

PUPPET CARE

When not in use cover with a plastic bag. For long term storage put your puppet back in the plastic bag it was shipped in and store in the shipping box in a cool, dry place. Keep out of direct / prolonged sunlight to avoid fading and degradation of rubber surfaces. **DO NOT** put item on top of your puppet when storing as the puppet may become deformed.

When not in use as a puppet you may use it as a static prop in a scene or display. It must remain in a "seated" position and cannot be in a "standing" position due to the design.

SOUND SYSTEM CARE - Please refer to the sound system instruction manual.

WARRANTY

- There are no refunds on purchased products.
